Regulations

(length in inches)

- 1. Pets, bicycles and motorized equipment are prohibited on trails. This includes horses.
- 2. Firearms and fireworks are prohibited in park.
- 3. Plants, wildlife, and all natural features are protected. Hunting and trapping are not permitted.
- 4. Be considerate of others. Keep noise low.

TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS

* RED FOX TRAIL 0.3 mile
A multipurpose wooded trail designed
for a sensory awareness experience.

GREEN DRAGON TRAIL 0.5 mile An undeveloped trail that wanders through the deep woods and along Coal Creek.

* BLUE HERON TRAIL 0.3 mile
A multipurpose, self-guided trail
with bird blinds overlooking Lake
Sherry.

PRAIRIE TRAIL 0.4 mile
This trail winds among the various
prairie plants and wildlife trails of
the old field area.

BLACKBIRD MARSH(0.7 mi. from building) A 600 foot boardwalk extends over the marsh allowing "hands-on" investigations of aquatic plants and animals.

WILDLIFE STUDY AREA TRAIL 0.6 mile A trail through diverse wildlife habitat where many tracks and signs of animals may be found.

The following trails begin at the North Woods Parking Area.

BEAVER LODGE TRAIL 1.0 mile A loop trail in the North Woods Area where recent beaver activity can easily be seen.

NORTH WOODS LOOP 1.3 mile This trail wanders through the old North Woods, the Nature Center's "wilderness" area.

SIERRA CLUB TRAIL 0.7 mile A trail which circles Nelson's Oxbow, home for many water animals and birds.
