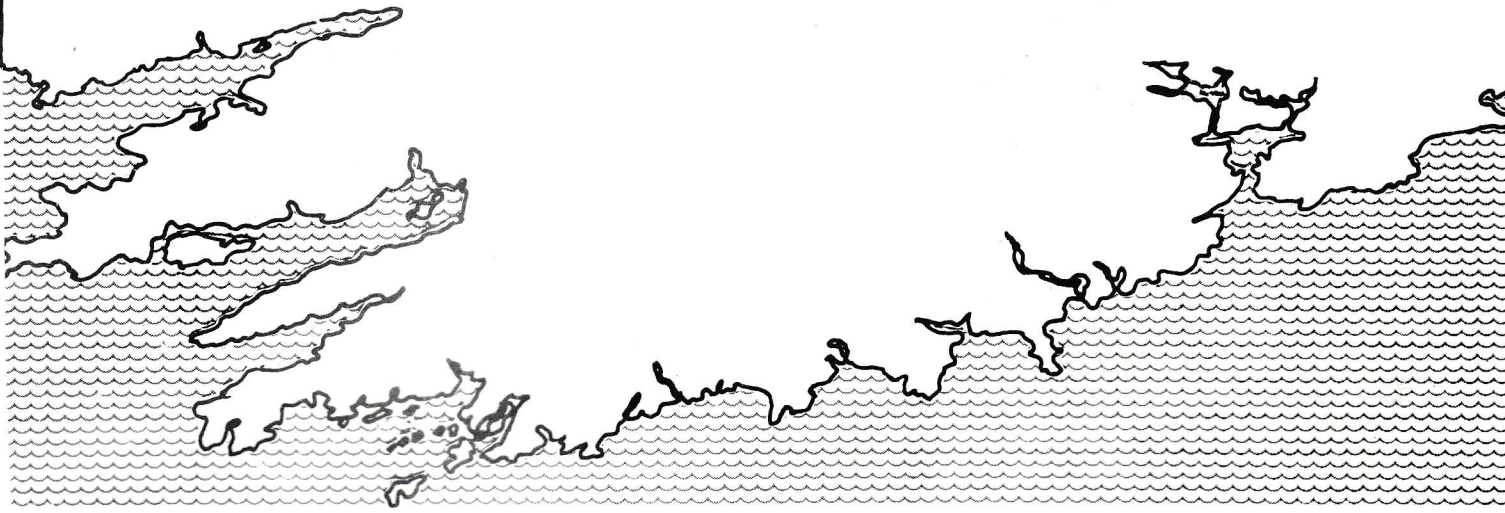

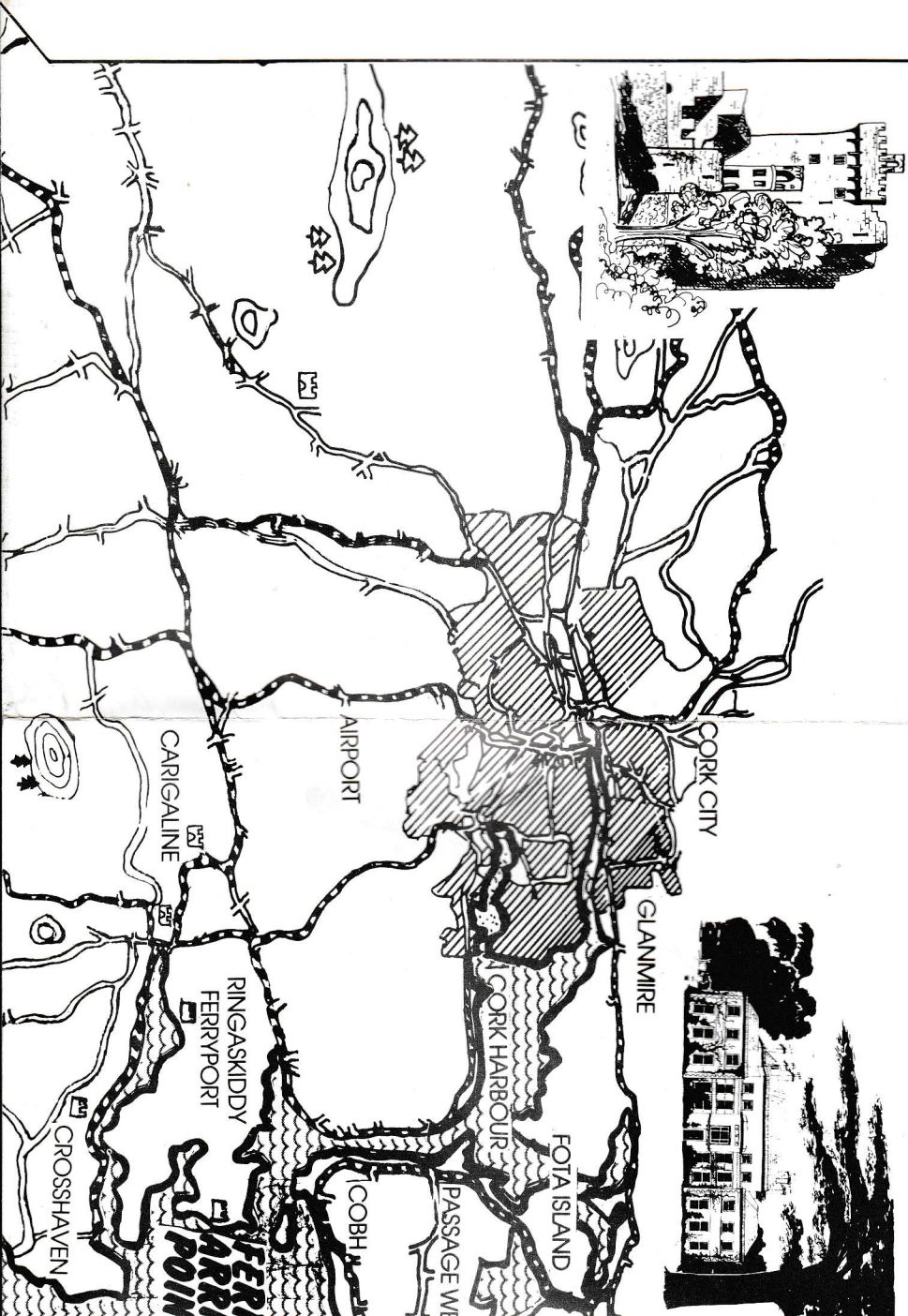
THE HOLIDAY COASTLINE

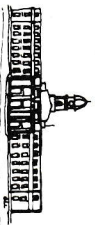
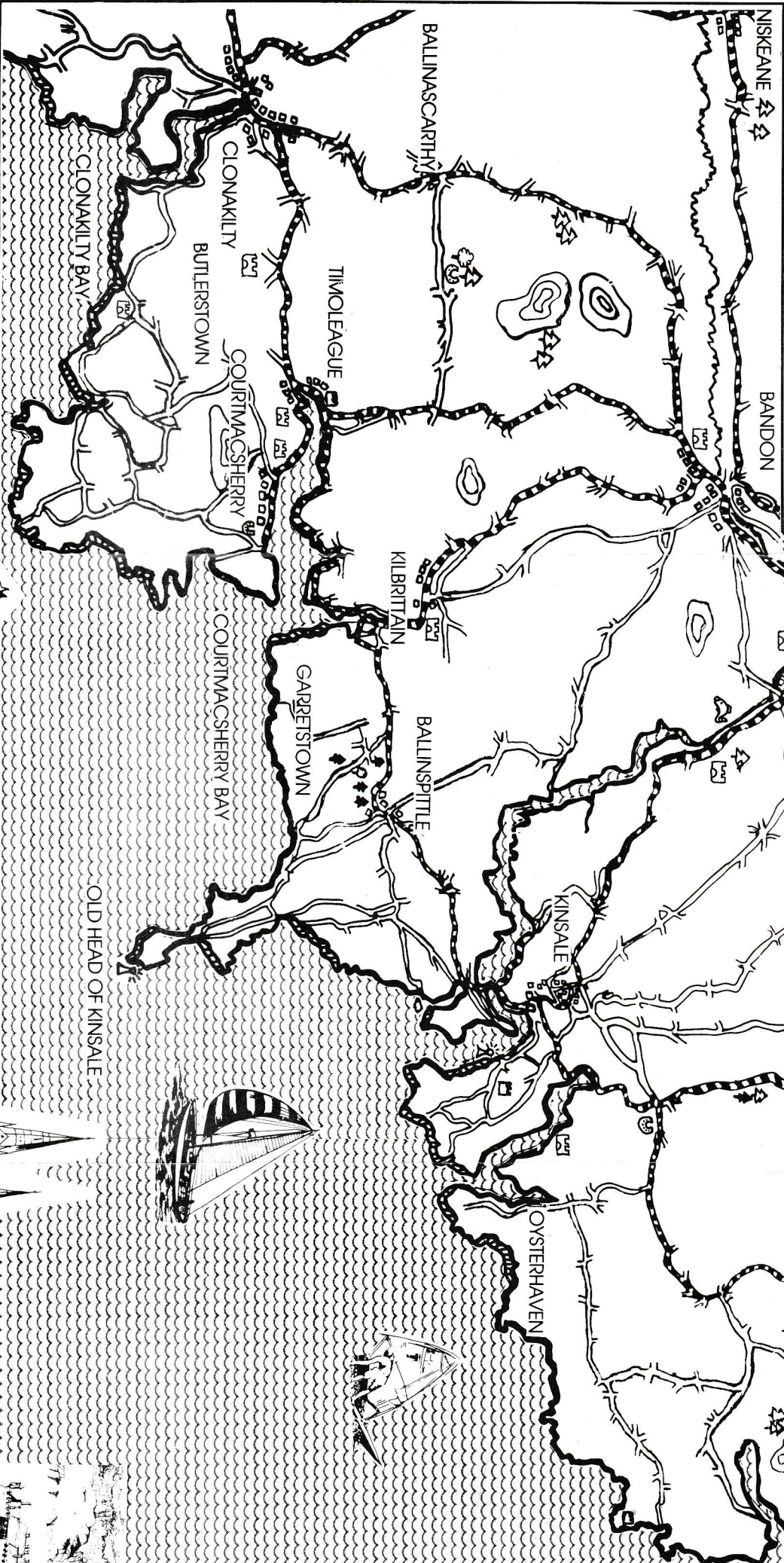

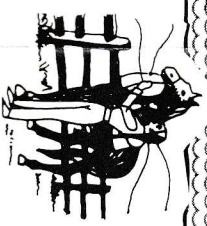

With good food, beautiful places to stay and many, many welcomes, you can have a great variety of holidays on this wonderful coast.

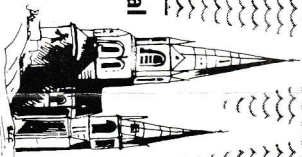
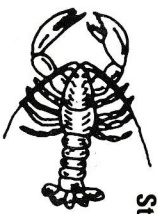




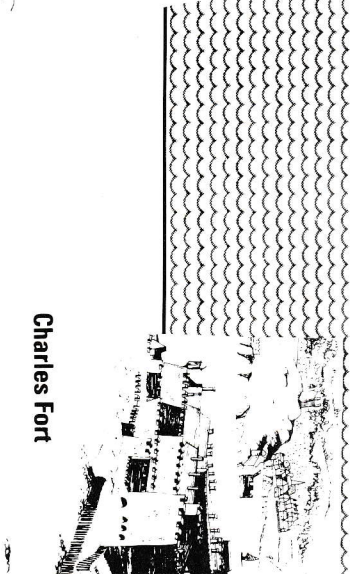

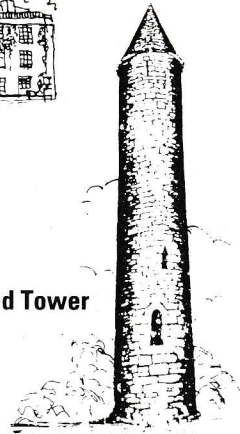
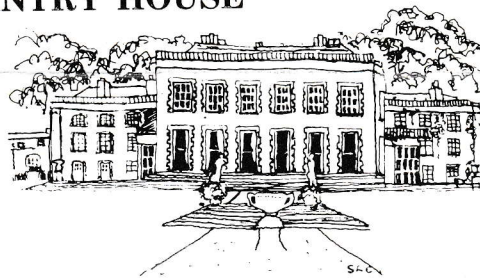
These maps are drawn in large scale and designed specially to provide information for holiday-makers.

There is a City Centre map with all the streets, monuments and places to see clearly shown. With it there is a major route map showing all the routes through the City and to the Coast.

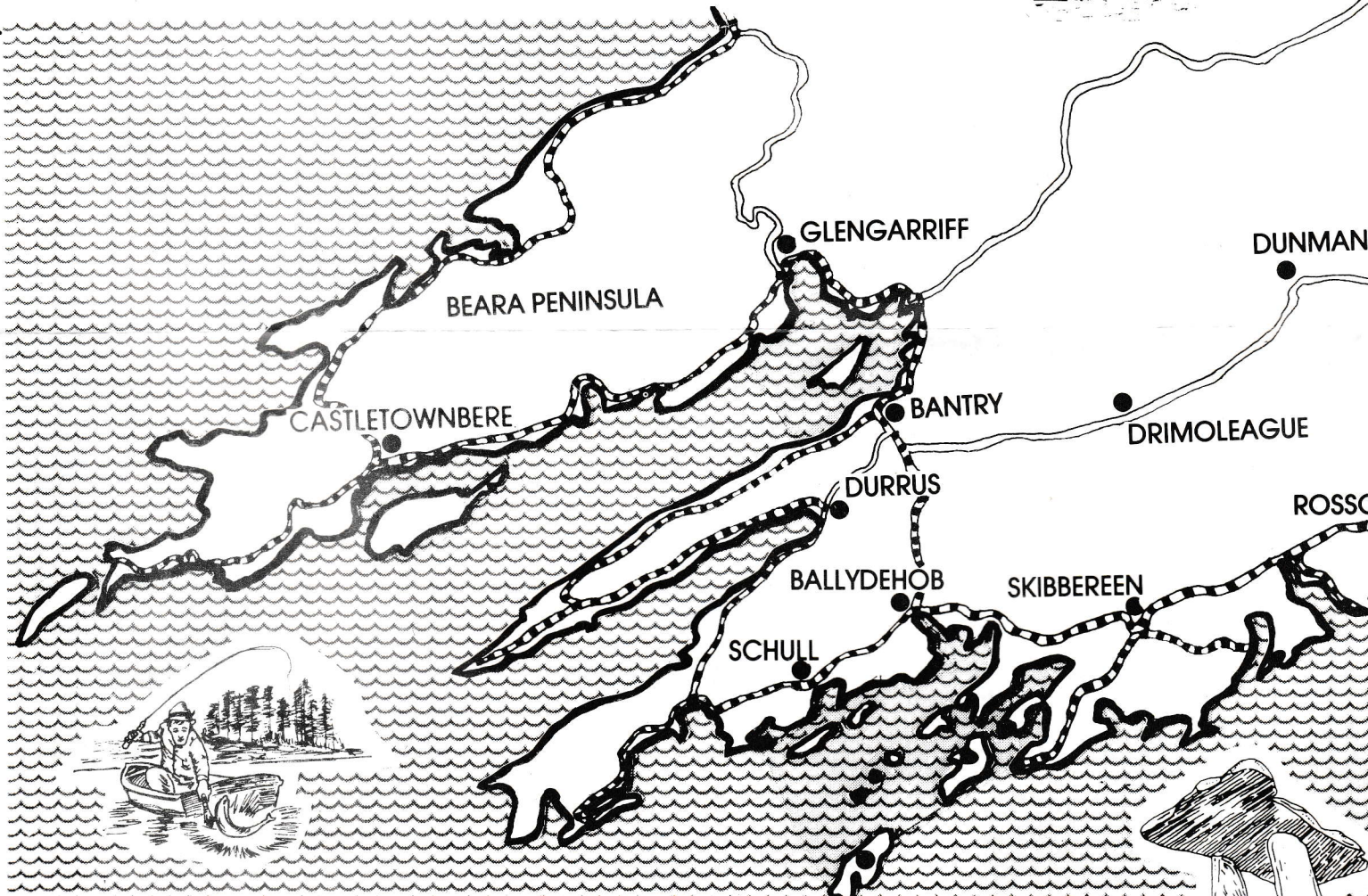
