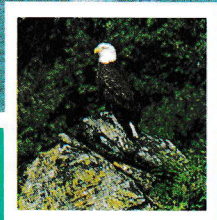

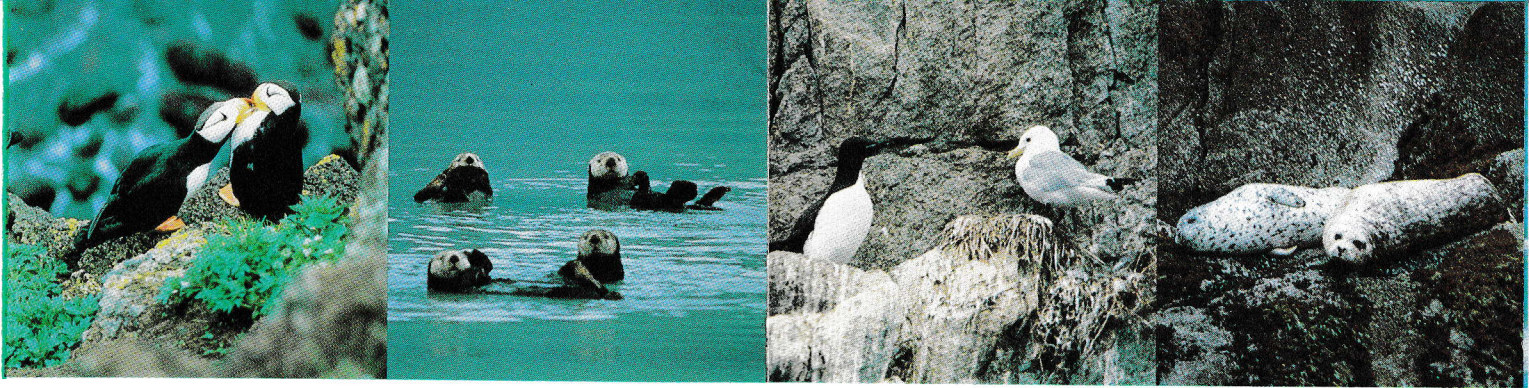

Welcome to the real Alaska! Treat yourself to a magnificent day in the Kenai Fjords National Park! Kenai Fjords National Park is a unique combination of massive glaciers and a remarkable abundance of marine wildlife. We offer full-day and half-day cruises daily, mid-May through mid-September.

All of our cruises view Resurrection Bay, a fjord in itself! Our half-day cruise specializes in Resurrection Bay with its abundant marine wildlife and scenic vistas.

The full-day cruise includes spectacular Holgate Glacier and the Chiswell Islands, a national wildlife refuge! There are over 100 species of birds which can usually be seen in the area, from the majestic bald eagle to the beloved puffin. We visit an eagle's nest and one small island which hosts over 20,000 horned and tufted puffins. You will see seals, sea otters, sea lion colonies and sometimes various species of whales. Variations in our tour will include Holgate, Aialik or Northwestern Glaciers. A half-hour is spent there listening and watching calving of ice from the glacier and the clinking of small bergy bits around the vessel. We then proceed to the Chiswell Islands to visit a kittiwake rookery; thousands of puffins; common murren rafting on the waves or standing in rows upon sheer cliffs and an awesome Stellar sea lion colony. We stop for photographs of wildlife and sea birds on all cruises. ***“Let Us Entertain Your Guests.”***

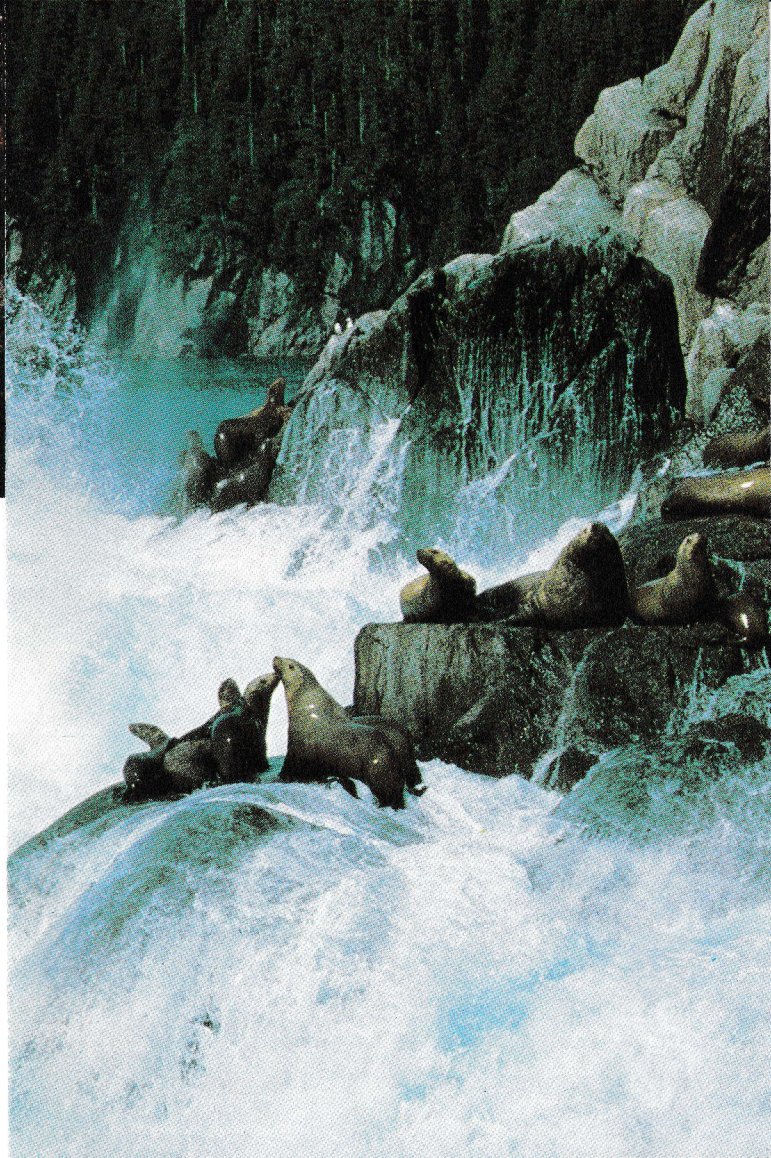
Transportation to Seward: Seward, located 129 scenic miles south of Anchorage can be reached by car, bus or train.

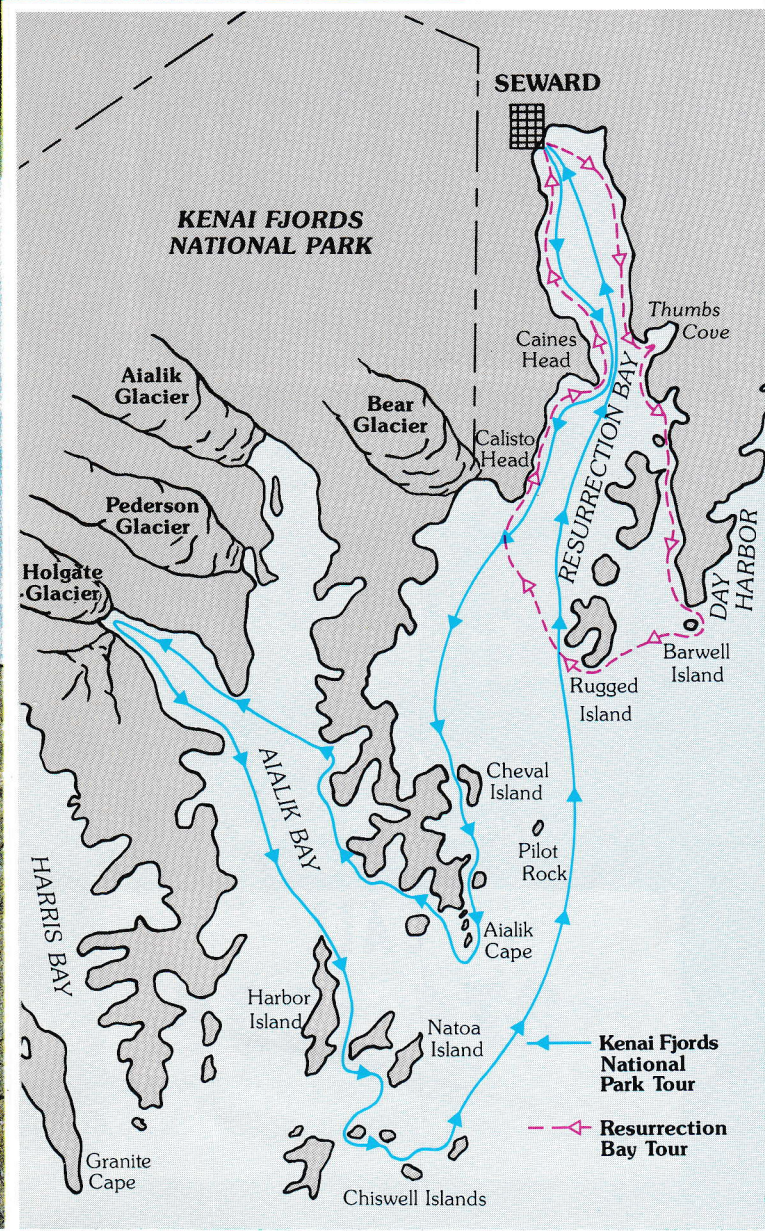
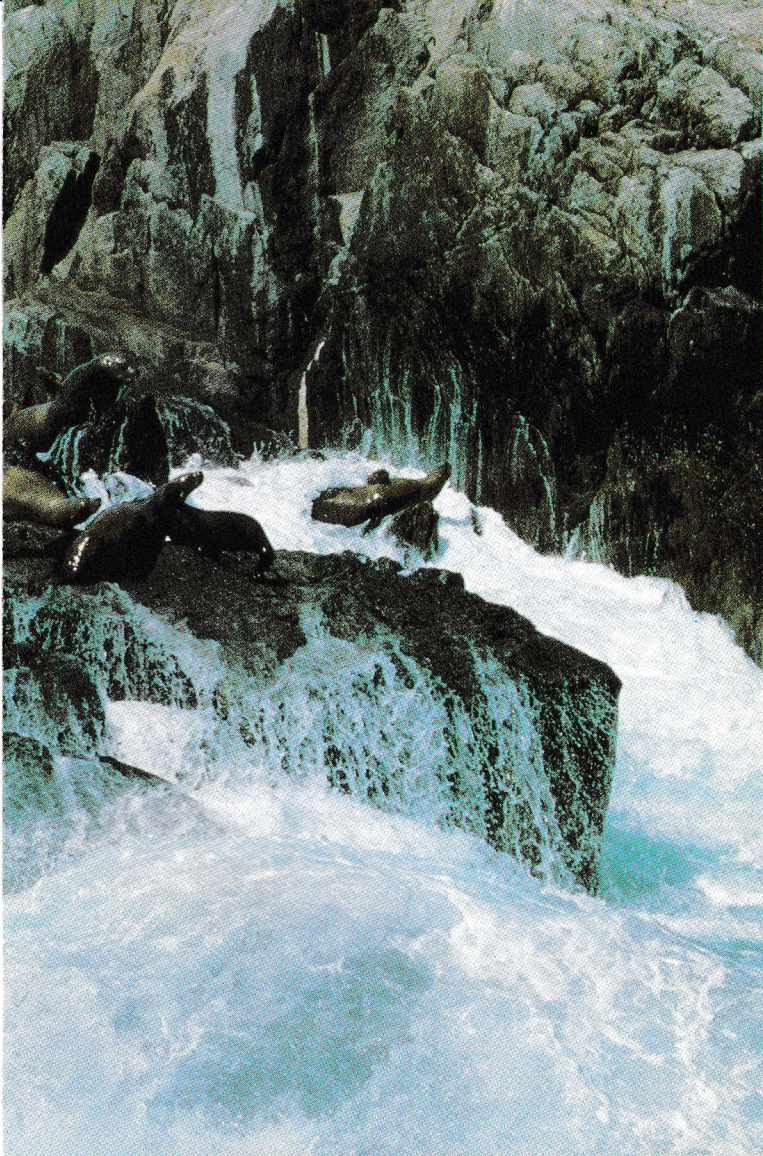
Bring your cameras (4 rolls of film minimum), binoculars and appropriate clothing to keep you warm and dry for your Kenai Fjords Tour.

Deposits: For tour reservations a 30% deposit is required. Balance is payable 2 weeks prior to departure. MasterCard/VISA accepted.

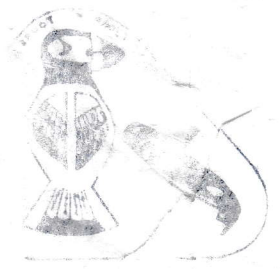
