





Prince William Sound is home to many birds and animals. Observe sea otters in Valdez Bay. Buoys Six and Nine are popular hangouts for sea lions. Look for whale and porpoise in Valdez Arm, and black bear, mountain goat and eagles along the coastal mountains and shoreline. At the glacier, seals are abundant.
