

## The bridge explained


There's no bridge quite like it in the world. The exhibition **INSIDE** the bridge reveals its fascinating story.

*(The exhibition may be listened to in French, German, Spanish, Italian and Japanese.)*




## The original Victorian engines



Learn how the bridge worked in the days of steam and admire the engines in their original setting.



**London's panoramic skyline**  
Spectacular panoramic views from 140ft above the Thames are enhanced by the use of interactive computers, which give detailed information about the attractions and well-known buildings along the banks of the Thames.



**H**utton's Emporium is the bridge's own Victorian style gift shop, offering a range of quality gifts and souvenirs of the period.
